

SUMMARY ANNUAL REPORT FOR NVIDIA WELFARE PLAN

This is a summary of the annual report of the Nvidia Welfare Plan (Employer Identification Number 94-3177549, Plan Number 502) for the plan year January 1, 2024 through December 31, 2024. The annual report has been filed with the Employee Benefits Security Administration, as required under the Employee Retirement Income Security Act of 1974 (ERISA).

Nvidia Corporation has committed itself to pay certain uninsured claims incurred under the terms of the plan.

Insurance Information

The plan has insurance contracts with National Union Fire Insurance Company of Pittsburgh, PA, Kaiser Foundation Health Plan Inc., Blue Cross and Blue Shield of Alabama, Cigna Health and Life Insurance Company, Prudential Insurance Company of America, Life Insurance Company of North America, The LegalEASE Group, Compsych Corporation, Delta Dental of California, Delaware American Life Insurance of America and University Health Alliance to pay certain accidental death & dismemberment, business travel accident, health, prescription drug, HMO contract, PPO contract, baby yourself and air medical services (AirMed), dental, evacuation, life insurance, temporary disability, long-term disability, AD&D, legal, employee assistance program claims incurred under the terms of the plan. The total premiums paid for the plan year ending December 31, 2024 were \$64,248,021.

Because they are so called "experience-rated" contracts, the premium costs are affected by, among other things, the number and size of claims. Of the total insurance premiums paid for the plan year ending December 31, 2024, the premiums paid under such "experience-rated" contracts were \$326,367 and the total of all benefit claims paid under these experience-rated contracts during the plan year was \$302,068.
