



Coaching Bootcamp

At a Glance

Overview

The Coaching Bootcamp gives organizations a scalable path to build validated AI skills. The program pairs GPU-backed NVIDIA **self-paced courses** for instruction and hands-on practice, with **Coaches** who provide the facilitation, structure, accountability, and support to participants - without needing to be technical instructors - culminating in an NVIDIA-Certified Associate credential.

Program Structure

In a coaching bootcamp, coaches guide groups through a curated learning and certification path built on NVIDIA self-paced courses, delivered over multiple weeks. Each week follows a consistent rhythm of coach-led sessions (2 x 1hr) and self-paced course study (~10 hrs). The full process - including the certification exam - takes two months or more, with duration varying by pathway.

Organization Requirements

- Nominate qualified candidates to become Certification Coaches
- Expand AI skills by preparing 1000+ participants for the exam
- Facilitate administrative coordination and communication for bootcamp.

Coach Candidacy Eligibility Requirements

- Foundational knowledge with the chosen learning and certification path
- Independent completion of all course materials, coaching requirements and passing the exam
- Upon completion of requirements, participants receive NVIDIA Certification Coach designation

Certification Coach Responsibilities

- Host kickoff sessions and provide content access
- Conduct regular office hours for coursework support
- Facilitate exam preparation sessions
- Keep learners motivated and on track

Getting Started

Organizations identify and nominate qualified candidates. Selected candidates receive training materials, GPU resources, and instructor support throughout the program.
